

ORSA AGM & Convention 2016 Sydney Itinerary



Iteniary for the ORSA 2016 Convention in Sydney from Wednesday 17th February until Sunday 21st February is as follows:

Thursday 18th – Golf Day – 8am arrival

We are hosting our golf day at Eastlake Golf Club (Gardeners Rd & Isaac Smith St, Daceyville NSW 2032), in an Ambrose format. Within this format, each player hits off the tee, the best shot is selected and all other players pick up their ball and place it, within one hand with, alongside the best ball. Each person then hits a second shot from the same spot. The best shot is again selected, and this continues until the ball is in the hole. On the green the best ball is marked and the other balls are played from this position. Each team then writes their team score, and the lowest team total after 18 wins the competition.

First tee off time is 9am, with a breakfast of bacon and eggs rolls included at 8am.

After the round, there is a lunch of Steak or Chicken, chips and salad included. We encourage people to hang around once they have finished for a few drinks and the presentation of prizes.
